- Knowledge of work processes and quality criteria primarily based on agile working methods and testing.
- Skills in planning, performing and identifying resources to develop modern, advanced web applications with an emphasis on frontend development.
- Skills in solving complex problems in web development and interface design and being able to reason the advantages and disadvantages of choosing different technical solutions.
- Skills in communicating undertakings and solutions in web development in Swedish and English.
- Competence to be independently responsible for frontend development in a web project. Ability to independently absorb new information and learn to master new languages and technologies in the field of web development in a way that leads to further learning and professional development.
- Competence to be involved in quality assurance of web development work by means of monitoring and following up to ensure that the project delivers what has been defined according to the specification, and, if necessary, communicate problems and propose solutions.
